

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AUXILIARY COUNTY POLICE FORCE

WHEREAS, the County of Scott has an established County Police Force pursuant to KRS 70.540 and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court has declared the need and advantages of an Auxiliary County Police Force to assist the County Police.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE FISCAL COURT, FOR THE COUNTY OF SCOTT, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, that:

Section 1. There is established by the Fiscal Court of Scott County an Auxiliary County Police Force to perform duties within the county upon such terms and conditions as the Fiscal Court deems necessary and proper.

Section 2. The Auxiliary County Police Force shall comprise no more than twelve (12) members.

Section 3. All members of the Auxiliary County Police Force shall:

- (a) Be appointed by the County Judge Executive and shall serve at his pleasure.
- (b) Not be construed to be within the definition and application of the terms "employee" or "patrolman" as provided in KRS 70.580.
- (c) Be answerable and under the direction of the County Judge Executive, except when the County Judge Executive delegates such authority to the chief officer of the County Police Force.
- (d) Not receive any compensation or benefits for his or her time or service, except that the Fiscal Court may provide for the payment of any reasonable and necessary expenses incurred by a member of the Auxiliary County Police Force in the conduct of his or her official duties.
- (e) Be appointed regardless of race, color, creed or position.
- (f) Give bond to the County Judge Executive in an amount determined or prescribed by the Fiscal Court. The Fiscal Court may authorize the premium thereof to be paid out of the general funds of the county.

Section 4. Should any part of this ordinance be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining part shall be severable and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
