

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ADVERTISING
ON COUNTY ROADS IN SCOTT COUNTY, KY.

WHEREAS, the use of posters, signs, notices and handbills on county roads and lanes results in unsightly litter and damage to utility poles, trees and fence posts and is a menace to residents;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Fiscal Court to prevent the undesirable effects listed above;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SCOTT COUNTY FISCAL COURT as follows:

Section One: Definitions:

A. Advertisements - any poster, sign, notice or handbill which is nailed or tacked to a utility pole, tree or fence post, including political posters and sales notices; b. County Roads or Lanes. Any road or lane within Scott County which is maintained by the county road department.

Section Two: No one shall post advertisements on any county road or lane within Scott County for any purpose. Anyone who posts such advertisements shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a fine of no less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100.09) Dollars.

Section Three: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.
