

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ROUTE OF GARBAGE TRUCKS TO AND FROM THE  
GEORGETOWN CITY DUMP ON  
SIMS ROAD (ROGERS GAP ROAD)

WHEREAS, the section of Rogers Gap Road known as Sims Road is unsuited for heavy truck traffic due to insufficient width and road base of Sims Road (Rogers Gap Road), and

WHEREAS, the section of Rogers Gap Road between U. S. 25 and the Georgetown City Dump is better suited to heavy truck travel due to its additional width and more substantial construction,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SCOTT COUNTY FISCAL COURT, SCOTT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, THAT:

Section 1. All trucks carrying garbage, trash or refuse of any kind shall travel to and from the Georgetown City Dump by way of U. S. 25 and Rogers Gap Road.

Section 2. No trucks carrying any of the materials listed in Section 1 shall use that section of the Sime Road (Rogers Gap Road) between the Delaplain Road and the Georgetown City Dump.

Section 3. Any owner or operator of any truck carrying any of the materials listed in Section 1 shall be guilty of a violation and subject to a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00.
