

ORDINANCE # 91-002

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE #89-0004 TO DEFINE UNIVERSAL COLLECTION AND PROVIDE FOR PERMIT REPORTING

WHEREAS, the Scott Fiscal Court has heretofore adopted Ordinance #89-0004 and known as "An Ordinance Regulating Solid Waste Management (Storage, Collection, Transportation, Processing and Disposal)", and

WHEREAS, there has arisen a need to amend and supplement Ordinance #89-0004 to maintain standards and current law for the health, education, safety, welfare and convenience of the inhabitants of Scott County:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Fiscal Court of the County of Scott of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, that:

Section 1 of Ordinance #89-0004 is amended to add the following definition:

"Universal Collection: A municipal solid waste collection system which is established by ordinance and approved by the cabinet and requires access for each household or solid waste generator in a county."

Section 3 of Ordinance #89-0004 is amended to add the following:

Section 3.8: Universal Collection

A municipal solid waste collection system which is established by ordinance and approved by the Cabinet and requires access for each household or solid waste generator in a county.

Section 6 of Ordinance #89-0004 is amended to add the following:

Section 6.11 Reporting Requirements:

A permit holder shall provide semi-annual reports to the county which update the information contained in the permit application and provide other such information as required by the Director, or County.

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any provisions or part thereof shall be held invalid or unconstitutional or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such invalidity, unconstitutionality or inapplicability shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
