

## 92-013

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CHANGING THE ZONE FOR 6.125 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, OWNED BY JAMES DWYER AND CANDACE DWYER, HUSBAND AND WIFE, SITUATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF U.S. 25 SOUTH (GEORGETOWN-LEXINGTON ROAD), SCOTT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, FROM AGRICULTURAL A-1 AND/OR RESIDENTIAL R-1 TO COMMERCIAL B-1.

WHEREAS, the joint application of James Dwyer and Candace Dwyer, husband and wife, having been filed with the Georgetown-Scott County Planning Commission on June 29, 1992, requesting a zoning classification change from Agricultural A-1 to Commercial B-2 for 12.861 acres, more or less, situated on the east side of U.S. 25 South (Georgetown-Lexington Road) in Scott County, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the matter having been heard publicly by the Planning Commission on August 13, 1992, pursuant to notice according to law and with a quorum present and voting; and

WHEREAS, after taking testimony on the Application and fully considering same, the hearing was continued; and

WHEREAS, an Amended Application having been filed with the Planning Commission on October 8, 1992, changing the request from 12.861 acres, more or less, to 6.125 acres, more or less, and the requested classification from Agricultural A-1 and/or Residential R-1 to Commercial B-1; and

WHEREAS, the Amended Application having been considered publicly by the Planning Commission at a continuation of the hearing thereon on October 8, 1992, at which time the Planning Commission voted to recommend to Scott Fiscal Court that the requested Application be granted; and

WHEREAS, Scott Fiscal Court, on November 6, 1992, after fully considering the application, record, and recommendation of the Planning Commission, voted unanimously to accept the Planning Commission's recommendation and granted the requested zoning classification change for the subject property from Agricultural A-1 and/or Residential R-1 to Commercial B-1.

JAMES DWYER AND CANDACE DWYER  
6.125 acre Zone Change

A tract of land located in Scott County, Kentucky on the east side of U.S. 25 at the Fayette County line and more particularly described as follows.

Beginning on the east side of U.S. 25 at the Scott-Fayette County line and remnant of stone fence and approximately 22 1/2 feet from the centerline of U.S. 25; thence along U.S. 25 and with remains of stone fence N 26 57'19" W 364.39 feet; thence N 27 17'06" W 293.39 feet; thence N 26 31'48" W 378.63 feet; thence leaving right-of-way and severing lands of Dwyer N 63 02'41" E 272.99 feet; thence S 19 47'44" E 213.04 feet; thence S 26 07'26" E 503.69 feet; thence S 37 03'57" E 340.36 feet to the Scott-Fayette County line; thence with the county line S 65 39'36" W 300.31 feet to the beginning.
