

ORDINANCE # 01-06**AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO REAPPORTIONMENT
AND LAYING OFF BOUNDARY LINES OF DISTRICTS
pursuant to KRS 67.045 et seq.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of the County of Scott, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION 1.

WHEREAS, by virtue of and pursuant to KRS 67.045 et seq., the Fiscal Court is to initiate reapportionment proceedings in May of the first year following the decennial census of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Scott Fiscal Court on May 24, 2001, voted to initiate reapportionment proceedings by appointment of three (3) competent citizens, over 21 years of age and residing in different districts and the County Clerk as a non-voting member as Commissioners to apportion Scott County into seven (7) Commissioner's districts and to complete same within sixty (60) days; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners having met, considered and voted upon their recommendations and submitting a written report to the County Clerk's Office and to the Scott Fiscal Court on 13 July, 2001, signed by the Commissioners and the Clerk as a non-voting member; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner's recommendations having been considered by the Scott Fiscal Court, at its regular meeting on July 26, 2001, to adopt or amend the report in establishing the districts and after due consideration and discussion Districts 1,2,3,4 and 7 were adopted in toto per the report and recommendations of the Commissioners.

Districts 5 and 6 were amended by the Fiscal Court as follows:

SCOTT COUNTY MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT FIVE

Begin at the intersection of the Southern Railroad and East Main Street Extended; thence south along Southern Railroad and city limits east of Maddox Street and back to Southern Railroad to intersection with Jackson Street; thence west following Jackson Street to Dudley Avenue; thence south following Dudley Avenue centerline to Clayton Avenue; thence west on Clayton Avenue to the intersection with US 25 (South Broadway); thence north along the east side of South Broadway across Main Street; thence continuing along North Broadway to the intersection with the city limits; thence east along the south side of city limits to North Elkhorn Creek; thence east along the said creek centerline to US 460 (Paris Road); thence southwest on Paris Road to the intersection with the Southern Railroad; thence south following the Southern Railroad to Main Street Extended and point of beginning.

SCOTT COUNTY MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT SIX

Begin at the intersection of the Southern Railroad and Jackson Street; thence west following Jackson Street to Dudley Avenue; thence south following Dudley Avenue centerline to Clayton Avenue; thence west on Clayton Avenue to the intersection with US 25 (South Broadway); thence north on South Broadway to the intersection with Main Street; thence west along the south side of Main Street to Bevins Lane and the west side of census block 1073; thence turning north following said census block line and Bevins Lane to meet North Elkhorn Creek; thence north along said creek to a point where the city limits joins the North Elkhorn Creek centerline; thence west following creek centerline and city limits to a point where the city limits diverges from the creek; thence south following city limits to US 460 (Frankfort Road); thence east on Frankfort Road to the US 460 Bypass; thence in a southeasterly direction following the north side of

the Bypass to the southwest corner of the city limits; thence north following the city limits to the intersection of powerline and city limits; thence north following powerline to Aztec Trail; thence east on Aztec Trail to Choctaw Trail; thence north on Choctaw Trail to Hiawatha Trail; thence east following Hiawatha Trail centerline to the intersection with South Broadway; thence east across South Broadway to Georgetown cemetery boundary; thence east along cemetery boundary to Georgetown Middle School back driveway; thence east across Louis B. Nunn Drive to city limits; thence north along city limits and Louis B. Nunn Drive to old Lemons Mill Road; thence east on Old Lemons Mill Road to Southern Railroad; thence north on Southern Railroad to Jackson Street and point of beginning.

The Fiscal Court voted 8-yes 0-no in favor of adopting the Districts 1,2,3,4 and 7 as recommended by the Commissioners, and 8-yes and 0-no to adopt the amended districts of 5 and 6 as noted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF SCOTT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The reapportioned Commissioner's Districts are henceforth to be as follows:

ALL OF THE PROPERTY ATTACHED HERETO AND MADEA PART HEREOF BY REFERENCE AS IF COPIED IN FULL AND SET FORTH HEREIN.

SECTION II. All precinct boundaries will remain the same as they are recorded in the County Clerk's Office.

SECTION III. Each chapter, section or, whenever divisible part section of this Ordinance is hereby declared to be separable, and the invalidity of any chapter, section or divisible part section shall not be construed to affect the validity of any other chapter, section or part section of this Ordinance.


SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall be effective for passage and publication according to law.

SCOTT COUNTY MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT ONE

Begin at Caney Creek Church Road and the Scott/Owen county line; thence in a Northeasterly direction following said county line to the Scott/Owen/Grant county line; thence following Scott/Grant county line around the Northern portion of the county to the Scott/Grant/Harrison county line; thence following the Scott/Harrison county line in a Southerly direction to the intersection with Finnell Pike; thence south along the west side of Finnell Pike to the intersection with Bailey Road; thence west on the north side of Bailey Road; thence west along the north side of Barkley Road to Kentucky Highway 922 (Turkey Foot Road); thence north along east side of Turkey Foot Road to Kentucky Highway 620 (Rogers Gap Road); thence southwest along the north side of Rogers Gap Road to centerline of I-75; thence south following centerline of I-75 to the intersection with Kentucky Highway 620 (Delaplain Road); thence west along centerline of Delaplain Road to the intersection with US Highway 25 (Cincinnati Road); thence south along the west side of Cincinnati Road to the intersection with Cardinal Drive; thence in a northwesterly direction following centerline of Cardinal Drive to the juncture with Long Lick Road; thence continuing in a Northwesterly direction along the northeast side of Long Lick Road to the intersection with Sutterville Road; thence northwest along the east side of Sutterville Road to Caney Creek Church Road; thence north along the east side of Caney Creek Church Road to the county line and point of beginning.

SCOTT COUNTY MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT TWO

Begin at Caney Creek Church Road and the Scott/Owen county line; thence in a southwesterly direction following said county line to the Scott/Owen/Franklin county line; thence south following Scott/Franklin county line past Kentucky Highway 1688 (Woodlake Road) to a point at a distance of 4,100 feet south of Woodlake Road where nearby stream would extend to county line; thence north along centerline of said stream to the intersection with Kentucky Highway 1688 (Woodlake Road); thence in an easterly direction along the north side of Woodlake Road to North Elkhorn Creek; thence following

North Elkhorn Creek east to the intersection with Galloway Road; thence north along the west side of Galloway Road to the intersection with Kentucky Highway 227 (Stamping Ground Road); thence southeast along east side of Stamping Ground Road to the intersection with US 460 (Frankfort Road); thence east along north side of Frankfort Road to the incorporated boundary for the City of Georgetown; thence northeast following city limits to a point where the city limits follows the North Elkhorn Creek; thence east following city limits and creek to a point where creek diverges from city limits; thence south following said creek to its southernmost point before turning east; thence shooting south to US 460 (Main Street); thence east along the north side of Main Street to the intersection with North Broadway; thence north along the west side of North Broadway (US 25) to the intersection with Cardinal Drive; thence in a northwesterly direction following centerline of Cardinal Drive to the juncture with Long Lick Road; thence continuing in a Northwesterly direction along the west side of Long Lick Road to the intersection with Sutterville Road; thence northwest along the west side of Sutterville Road to Caney Creek Church Road; thence north along the west side of Caney Creek Church Road to the county line and point of beginning.

SCOTT COUNTY MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT THREE

Begin at the intersection of the Southern Railroad and the Scott/Fayette county line; thence in a southwesterly direction following the Scott/Fayette county line to the Scott/Fayette/Woodford county line; thence in a northwesterly direction following the Scott/Woodford county line to the Scott/Woodford/Franklin county line; thence following the Scott/Franklin county line north to a point at a distance of 4,100 feet south of Woodlake Road, where nearby stream would extend to county line (before KY1688); thence north along centerline of said stream to the intersection with Kentucky Highway 1688 (Woodlake Road); thence in an easterly direction along the south side of Woodlake Road to North Elkhorn Creek; thence following North Elkhorn Creek east to the intersection with Galloway Road; thence north along the east side of Galloway Road to the intersection with Kentucky Highway 227 (Stamping Ground Road); thence southeast

along west side of Stamping Ground Road to the intersection with US 460 (Frankfort Road); thence east along south side of Frankfort Road to the US 460 Bypass; thence in a southeasterly direction following the south side of the Bypass to the southwest intersection of the city limits and the Bypass; thence east following city limits to US 25 (Lexington Road); thence south along the west side of Lexington Road to the intersection with Cane Run Creek; thence east along the Cane Run Creek centerline to the intersection with the Southern Railroad; thence south along the railroad centerline to the county line and point of beginning.

SCOTT COUNTY MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT FOUR

Begin at Finnell Pike at the Scott/Harrison county line; thence south along the east side of Finnell Pike to the intersection with Bailey Road; thence west on the south side of Bailey Road; thence west along the south side of Barkley Road to Kentucky Highway 922 (Turkey Foot Road); thence north along west side of Turkey Foot Road to Kentucky Highway 620 (Rogers Gap Road); thence southwest along the south side of Rogers Gap Road to centerline of I-75; thence south following centerline of I-75 to the intersection with Kentucky Highway 620 (Delaplain Road); thence west along centerline of Delaplain Road to the intersection with US Highway 25 (Cincinnati Road); thence south along the east side of Cincinnati Road to the intersection with the city limits; thence east along the north side of the city limits to North Elkhorn Creek; thence east following the centerline of said creek to the intersection with I-75; thence south following I-75 centerline to the Scott/Fayette county line; thence east along Scott/Fayette county line to the Scott/Fayette/Bourbon county line; thence north following Scott/Bourbon county line to the intersection of the Scott/Bourbon/Harrison county lines; thence north following the Scott/Harrison county line to Finnell Pike and point of beginning.

SCOTT COUNTY MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT FIVE

Begin at the intersection of the Southern Railroad and East Main Street Extended; thence south along Southern Railroad and city limits east of Maddox Street and back to Southern Railroad to intersection

with Jackson Street; thence west following Jackson Street to Dudley Avenue; thence south following Dudley Avenue centerline to Clayton Avenue; thence west on Clayton Avenue to the intersection with US 25 (South Broadway); thence north along the east side of South Broadway across Main Street; thence continuing along North Broadway to the intersection with the city limits; thence east along the south side of city limits to North Elkhorn Creek; thence east along the said creek centerline to US 460 (Paris Road); thence southwest on Paris Road to the intersection with the Southern Railroad; thence south following the Southern Railroad to Main Street Extended and point of beginning.

SCOTT COUNTY MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT SIX

Begin at the intersection of the Southern Railroad and Jackson Street; thence west following Jackson Street to Dudley Avenue; thence south following Dudley Avenue centerline to Clayton Avenue; thence west on Clayton Avenue to the intersection with US 25 (South Broadway); thence north on South Broadway to the intersection with Main Street, thence west along the south side of Main Street to Bevins Lane and the west side of census block 1073; thence turning north following said census block line and Bevins Lane to meet North Elkhorn Creek; thence north along said creek to a point where the city limits joins the North Elkhorn Creek centerline; thence west following creek centerline and city limits to a point where the city limits diverges from the creek; thence south following city limits to US 460 (Frankfort Road); thence east on Frankfort Road to the US 460 Bypass; thence in a southeasterly direction following the north side of the Bypass to the southwest corner of the city limits; thence north following the city limits to the intersection of powerline and city limits; thence north following powerline to Aztec Trail; thence east on Aztec Trail to Choctaw Trail; thence north on Choctaw Trail to Hiawatha Trail; thence east following Hiawatha Trail centerline to the intersection with South Broadway; thence east across South Broadway to Georgetown cemetery boundary; thence east along cemetery boundary to Georgetown Middle School back driveway; thence east across Louis B. Nunn Drive to city limits; thence north along city limits and Louis B. Nunn Drive to Old Lemons Mill Road; thence east

on Old Lemons Mill Road to Southern Railroad; thence north on Southern Railroad to Jackson Street and point of beginning.

SCOTT COUNTY MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT SEVEN

Begin at I-75 and the Scott/Fayette county line; thence north following centerline of I-75 to where said road crosses North Elkhorn Creek; thence west of said creek to the intersection with Paris Road; thence west following Paris Road to Southern Railroad; thence south on centerline of Southern Railroad across East Main Street Extended; continuing south along Southern Railroad and city limits east of Maddox Street and back to Southern Railroad to intersection with Old Lemons Mill Road; thence west on centerline of Old Lemons Mill Road to Louis B. Nunn Drive; thence south on Louis B. Nunn Drive and city limits to Georgetown Middle School back driveway; thence west to Georgetown cemetery boundary; continuing west along the south side of cemetery boundary to US 25 (South Broadway) and across South Broadway to Hiawatha Trail; thence west along the centerline of Hiawatha Trail to Choctaw Trail; thence south on Choctaw Trail to Aztec Trail; thence west on Aztec Trail to powerline; thence south along powerline to Bypass; thence southeast along Bypass to southeast junction of city limits and Bypass; thence east along city limits to US 25 (Lexington Road); thence south on US 25 to Cane Run Creek; thence east along centerline of said creek to Southern Railroad; thence south on Southern Railroad to Fayette County line; thence east along Scott/Fayette county line to I-75 and point of beginning.
