

**ORDINANCE NO. 2000-03**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LICENSE  
FEE AS SET OUT IN ORDINANCE NO. 85-020**

WHEREAS, the existing Scott County License Ordinance No. 85-020 makes no provision for extraordinary and unusual income such as the National Tobacco Settlement, and

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the Scott Fiscal Court that the income from the National Tobacco Settlement to the tobacco farmers and owners of Scott County is compensation for damages, loss of income and to ease the burden of transition to other farm income producing activities and is not to be counted as income within the meaning and intent of Ordinance No. 85-020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SCOTT FISCAL COURT AS FOLLOWS:


Section One: All amounts received by Scott County Tobacco farmers and owners, from the National Tobacco Settlement, for purposes of Scott County Ordinance No. 85-020, shall be excluded as income.


Section Two: This Ordinance shall be effective retroactively to tax years beginning after December 31, 1998.

Section Three: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication.

The foregoing Ordinance was introduced for the first reading at a regular meeting held Feb. 11, 2000, and for the second time on Feb. 24, 2000, when it was adopted and approved.
