

ORDINANCE #96-012

**AN ORDINANCE TO DISCONTINUE A PORTION OF STOCKDELL ROAD
(A COUNTY ROAD) .**

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 178.050 et seq., the Scott Fiscal Court has proposed and recommended that approximately 8,912 feet of Stockdell Road, a County Road, be discontinued; and

WHEREAS, due notice of the proposed discontinuance by Scott Fiscal Court was published pursuant to KRS Chapter 424 and in addition by placing such notices at three (3) public places in the vicinity of the road to be discontinued; and

WHEREAS, the Scott Fiscal Court did appoint two (2) viewers, who, together with the County Road Engineer viewed the road and submitted a report in writing at a public hearing on October 7, 1996, that no inconvenience would result in the closing of Stockdell Road as proposed; and

WHEREAS, the Scott Fiscal Court having considered such report and other evidences and is satisfied that there is no public inconvenience by reason of the discontinuance of Stockdell Road as described in the "Notice to Discontinue County Road", passed 16 September, 1996.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNTY OF SCOTT, KENTUCKY, ACTING BY AND
"THROUGH ITS FISCAL COURT", DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That the Scott Fiscal Court shall discontinue from the county road system and close that portion of Stockdell Road described as follows:

That portion of Stockdell Road beginning at a point in the southeastern right of way of Gaines Road, thence proceeding in a southerly direction with the meandering of Stockdell Road for a distance of approximately 8,912 feet to a point at an existing culvert near the northwestern boundary of the Coffman Glass property, to its terminus which shall be closed and discontinued as a county road. The remaining distance of approximately 1,850 feet to the Skinnersburg Road shall remain open as a public county road.


Section 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and, if any section, phrase or provision shall, for any reason, be declared invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 3. In the event of any conflict or conflicts between the provisions of this Ordinance and of any prior Ordinances, Orders or Resolutions or parts thereof, the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.


Section 4. Upon adoption by the Scott Fiscal Court, his Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
