

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE "ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROVISION OF FUNDS TOWARD THE PAYMENT FOR INDIGENT HOSPITAL CARE" HERETOFORE PASSED FEBRUARY 7, 1983.**

**ORDINANCE # 96-013**

**WHEREAS**, the Scott Fiscal Court on February 7, 1983, passed and approved for adoption an Ordinance Related to the Partial Funding of Indigent Hospital Care in Scott County; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears that said Ordinance has exceeded the authority of the Fiscal Court to bind another and to require a referendum to terminate the dedication; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears that said Ordinance was not published as prescribed by law; and

**WHEREAS**, the current Fiscal Court wishes to clarify the status of the prior Ordinance and to nullify same officially;


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNTY OF SCOTT, KENTUCKY, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS FISCAL COURT, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN: AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Ordinance passed February 7, 1985 and styled "An Ordinance Relating to the Provision of Funds Toward the Payment for Indigent Hospital Care" is repealed and shall henceforth be null, void and of no effect whatsoever.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 09-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF GENERAL RULES GOVERNING  
THE APPOINTMENT AND TERMS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, the Scott Fiscal Court accepted Ordinance No. 99-10 on October 14, 1999 establishing general rules governing the appointment and terms of boards and commissions; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance contains a provision causing the County Judge Executive Office to maintain copies of meeting minutes from each and every Board and Commission and it also contains a provision requiring each Board-to provide the Scott County Judge's Office a copy of its budget within 30 days of the approval; and

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that the courage of the minutes places an unduly burdensome requirement on said Office, and each Board/Commission is statutorily required to submit its budget to the Scott Fiscal Court on or before June 1st of each year; and

WHEREAS, the Scott Fiscal Court now desires to change said ordinance;  
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE SCOTT FISCAL COURT THAT  
ORDINANCE NO. 99-10 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS  
AND NOTHING HEREIN SHOULD BE CONSTRUED AS AMENDING OR WAIVING ANY  
OTHER PROVISION OF ORDINANCE NO. 99-10 (AS AMENDED):

SECTION TWO: REGULATIONS:

All Boards and Commissions whether appointed by the Scott County Judge Executive and approved by the Fiscal Court or appointed solely by the' Fiscal Court shall be governed by the following regulations:

A. Files will be maintained by the County Judge Executive's Office which lists the member's names, terms, expiration dates and annual budget for each board or commission over which the County has jurisdiction by means of appointment or appropriations.

B. Each board shall provide to the Scott County Judge's Office a copy of its budget on or before June 1st of each year.

SECTION THREE: EFFECTIVE DATE:


This Amendment to Ordinance No. 99-10 shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
