ORDINANCE NO. 23-03

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RESERVOIR PROPERTY ADVISORY
BOARD

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statute 67.710(8) authorizes the county judge/executive to, with the approval of the fiscal court, make appointments to or remove members from such boards as the fiscal court may by ordinance create; and

WHEREAS, Scott County owns a number of parcels in the area of Skinnersburg Road, Gaines Road, Stockdell Road, and Coppage Road, collectively referred to as "Reservoir Property." identified in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, the Reservoir Property is used by a number of citizens and groups for recreational purposes including but not limited to horseback riding, biking, and hiking, all of which enhance the quality of life of the citizens of Scott County and bring economic benefit and tourism to the community; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Scott County Fiscal Court to preserve and protect the natural environment in the Reservoir Property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SCOTT COUNTY FISCAL COURT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Scott County Reservoir Property Board is hereby established and shall meet a minimum of four (4) times annually in a location provided by the Court. The Board shall be comprised of twelve (12) members, nine (9) of which shall be volunteer members and three (3) of which shall be ex officio members. The ex officio members shall be the Director of Georgetown/Scott County Parks & Recreation, the Director of the Scott County Road Department, and the Director of Georgetown/Scott County Tourism. The nine (9) volunteer members shall be appointed by the County Judge/Executive with approval of the Fiscal Court, shall have lived in the County for at least one (1) year prior to appointment, and shall have demonstrated an interest in horseback riding, biking, hiking, environmental preservation, or a related area.

SECTION 2: The appointment term of each volunteer board member shall be four (4) years, except for initial appointment terms. Initial appointment terms shall be as follows: three (3) members shall be appointed to a one (1) year term; three (3) members shall be appointed to two (2) year terms; and three (3) members shall be appointed to a three (3) year term.

SECTION 3: There shall be no compensation for services of board members.

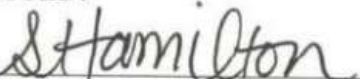
SECTION 4: The Scott County Reservoir Property Board shall have the purpose and power to make non-binding recommendations to the Scott County Fiscal Court regarding the use, management, and maintenance of the Reservoir Property. The Board's role in carrying out this purpose will entail suggesting methods to protect the scenic, biological, ecological and geological attributes of the Reservoir Property, to minimize the impact to the environment and to maintain a trail system of good quality.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
