

ORDINANCE NO. 23-09

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE UPDATED GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES FOR MAGISTERIAL DISTRICTS IN SCOTT COUNTY

SUMMARY


1. Provides that pursuant to KRS 67.045, which sets out the legal process requiring that county magisterial boundaries be redrawn based upon the population figures resulting from each decennial census, the Fiscal Court has appointed three (3) citizen members to a Magisterial Reapportionment Commission with the County Clerk serving a nonvoting member, which has produced a written report establishing the estimated population of each magisterial district and its recommendation as to the new geographic boundaries of each district and filed that report with the Scott County Clerk and each Magistrate on July 20, 2023.
2. Adopts the recommendations of the Magisterial Reapportionment Commission with the exception of modifications to District 3 and District 4 as amended by the Scott County Fiscal Court and provides a written description of the precinct boundaries and locations.
3. Directs that all precinct boundaries and locations shall be set by the Scott County Clerk's Office and be recorded for public notice and access purposes.
4. Takes effect on November 8, 2023.
