

INVITATION TO BID
MT HOREB RD OVER GOOSE CREEK
BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Scott County Fiscal Court will receive sealed bids in the office of the County Judge Executive, Scott County Courthouse, 101 East Main Street #210, Georgetown, Kentucky until 2:00 P.M., EDT September 9, 2025.

The purpose of this project is to replace the existing single span bridge with a new KYTC Standard Drawing single span composite box beam bridge and reconstruct the roadway approach to the proposed bridge. The proposed bridge is located on Mt Horeb Rd 1.8 miles northeast of Mt. Horeb Pike and 0.8 miles southwest of Carrick Pike in Scott County, Kentucky.

Each bid shall be submitted on bid proposal forms, in the contract documents, signed in ink and sealed in an envelope conspicuously marked: "Mt Horeb Rd over Goose Creek Bridge Replacement Project"

The Scott County Fiscal Court reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals and waive irregularities or technicalities, as the Court deems necessary to best serve its interest.

Each sealed proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or satisfactory bid bond, in a sum that is not less than five (5) percent of the aggregate amount of bid, payable to the Scott County Fiscal Court.

The successful bidder will be required to execute Contract and to provide Contract Surety in an amount equal to one hundred (100) percent of the bid amount for performance, and a bond in the amount equal to one hundred (100) percent of the bid amount guaranteeing the payment of all labor, materials, and etc.

If awarded the Contract, the work will be completed within ninety (90) consecutive calendar days. This contract time begins ten (10) calendar days after the Notice to Proceed is issued.

Rights to waive any formality in any proposed guaranty, to reject any and all bids, and to negotiate with the apparent low bidder to such extent as may be necessary, are reserved.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

All Bidders shall be pre-qualified with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet at the time of the bid opening.
