Section 11. EXCEPTIONS TO LICENSING REQUIREMENT:

(1) Public Utility companies and corporations engaged in the manufacture or distribution of electrical energy for commercial purposes, or their employees, shall not be required to obtain licenses for the manufacture, transmission, distribution and metering of electrical energy and all repairs and maintenance connected therewith. Communication and related companies shall not be required to obtain licenses to engage in these activities

(2) Any electrical contractor or journeyman who travels into this area and who can document at least five years of experience in the field for which a license is sought shall not be required to be examined prior to being issued a license if the person has been licensed in a jurisdiction which requires an examination as stringent as that required by this Article, except an examination may be required in such instances where the board entertains a substantial doubt as to the nature or quality of the applicant's work.

(3) Any owner/occupant of a single family dwelling may perform his or her own electrical work

(4) In the event of the death of the person carrying the Contractor's License for an Electrical Contracting business, that business shall have 120 days in which to qualify the decedent's successor as a licensed electrical contractor under this ordinance.

Section 12. ANNUAL LICENSE FEES:

(1) The annual license fee for Class A Electrical Contractors shall be One-Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), the annual license fee for Class B Journeyman shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and the annual license fee for Class C Apprentice shall be Twenty-five (\$25.00). The Class A, Class Band Class C licenses shall expire December 31st of each year and the examining board shall renew the licenses for a one year period. Upon the failure of licensee to apply for renewal on or before the 31 st of January immediately following expiration of the license, the licensee shall be assessed a fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). Upon the failure of the licensee to apply for renewal within One Hundred and Twenty (120) days after the date of expiration, the licensee shall be required to pass the board's required examination before another license is issued.
