

j. In the event the County enters an Interlocal Agreement (approved November 10, 2016), pursuant to KRS 65.210 to 65.300 and 65.8811, for joint Code Enforcement, appointment of members and alternate, removal, and qualifications shall be governed by the terms of the Interlocal Agreement, with each participating jurisdiction appointing at least one member. Two (2) or more participating local governments may share an appointment or appointments.

k. Each member of the Code Enforcement Board shall have resided within the boundaries of the County for a period at least one (1) year prior to the date of the member's appointment and shall reside there throughout the term in office. In the event the County enters an Interlocal Agreement (approved November 10, 2016), pursuant to KRS 65.210 to 65.300 and 65.8811, for joint Code Enforcement, Board members serving on joint code enforcement boards shall have resided within the boundaries of the local government they represent for a period of at least one ( ) year prior to the date of the member's appointment and shall reside there throughout the term in office.

#### 7. Organization of Board; Quorum.

a. The Board shall, upon the initial appointment of its members, and annually thereafter, elect a Chair from among its members. The Chairperson shall be the presiding officer and a full voting member of the board. If the chairperson is not present at a meeting, the Board shall select one of its members to preside in place of and exercise the powers of the chairperson.

b. The Board shall hold regular meetings at least monthly on a schedule to be determined by the Board. Meetings other than established regular meetings shall be special meetings held in accordance with the Kentucky Open Meetings Act.

c. All meetings and hearings of the Board shall be held in accordance with the applicable State statutes and the Kentucky Open Meetings Act.

d. The presence of at least a majority of the Board's entire membership shall constitute a quorum. The affirmative vote of a majority of the members constituting a quorum shall be necessary for any official action to be taken. Any member of the Board who has any direct or indirect financial or personal interest in any matter to be decided shall disclose the nature of the interest and shall qualify himself from voting on the matter and shall not be counted for purposes of establishing a quorum.

e. Minutes shall be kept for all proceedings of the Board, and the vote of each member on any issue decided by the Board shall be recorded in the minutes.

f. All meetings and hearings of the code enforcement board shall be open to the public.

g. The County shall provide clerical and administrative personnel for the proper conduct of the duties of the Board. [In the event the County enters an Interlocal Agreement (approved November 10, 2016)] pursuant to KRS 65.210 to 65.300 and 65.8811, for joint Code
